# Forest St. Community Garden Membership

The goal of the Forest St. Community Garden is to provide an area for individuals and families to learn how to garden, to build and nurture community friendships and to increase access to high quality, organic produce for Eau Claire residents who may not have access due to lack of finances, education or due to current life situation. Extra produce is regularly donated to the Community Table (320 Putnam Street Eau Claire, WI 54703).

The Forest St. Community Garden also serves as a learning community for Members to gain experience in leadership, teaching, coordinating and community outreach.

## Membership Benefits

- Members of the Forest St. Community Garden are welcome to participate in weekly gardening sessions as often as possible.
- When produce is ready and available, members who volunteer during gardening sessions are welcome to high quality, organic produce after each session.
- Gardening sessions serve as social events for Members to connect with each other and to learn more about gardening.
- Members are invited to and encouraged to participate in Community Days and other community education events.
- Members are invited to participate in Garden potlucks and campfires!
- Members may invite friends to participate in garden sessions and events.

# Eau Claire Forest St. Community Garden Guidelines:

- Leave the garden looking better than you found it. Help with putting away equipment at the end of garden sessions.
- Follow-through with responsibilities and contact the coordinators or appropriate person/s as soon as possible if you cannot cover your duties (leading gardening sessions, mowing or watering, etc.). Please find a sub or contact the coordinators or appropriate person as soon as possible.
- Whenever possible, arrive at the beginning of gardening sessions so that the session leader does not need to repeat instructions.
- Include and engage others in all activities, the Forest St. Community Garden is a Safe Space and is inclusive to all people.
- Do not harvest produce outside of gardening sessions unless you have permission from the coordinators and/or are harvesting for an approved program or donation. (If your schedule does not work with gardening sessions, we will find another option for you).
- You, your family and friends are welcome to be in the garden at any time you like so long as it doesn't interfere with educational sessions or related activities that are in-session. Non-Members can participate in Community Days and are welcome to participate in other events.
- Do not remove tools or equipment from gardening site unless specified to do so.
- Please walk with care, and do not trample surrounding plants. Please watch children and monitor their activities so that they do not disturb plots or damage plants.
- Pets are welcome though not encouraged in the gardening area. Please prevent your pet from wandering through the gardens and trampling plants or going to the bathroom in the gardening area.
- If you have a concern or issue with a Member please address it with them in a timely manner. If the issue cannot be resolved please communicate with the garden coordinators as they can aid in the manner and help resolve conflict.
- If you have a concern or issue with your responsibilities please communicate your issue with garden coordinators; we want you to feel as comfortable as possible with your membership.
- I understand that the use of the Forest St. Community Garden falls subject to a lease between the North River Fronts Neighborhood Assn. All reasonable efforts are made to come to agreement with the city about policies and procedures for using this city land. Once the lease is signed all volunteers and gardeners must follow rules outlined in the lease.
- I understand that neither the Forest St. Community Garden Coordinators, the City of Eau Claire, nor the North River Fronts Neighborhood are responsible for my actions.
